

On Thursday, 02 June 2022, pre-parking will be available from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and the entry of the paddock and pit garages is possible from 7 p.m. on.

There is also a parking area outside of the race track – in front of the main building for private cars.

Trailer parking - directions



Going on and off the track for Quali's and Races

The routing to go on and off the track for **race cars**:

• <u>Going on:</u> access / pre-start at the Medical Center (red line in picture)




• <u>Going off:</u> at the end of pit lane through the "drivethrough" box (Nr. 33) (blue line in picture)



The routing to go on and off the track for **mechanics**:

• <u>Going on:</u> access via pre-start at Medical Center – then pit entry gate

<u>Going off:</u> at the end of pit lane through the "drive-through" box

The series coordinators of all teams will receive the tickets and accreditations in advance from the organization team. All drivers will have to collect their tickets and accreditations from the respective series coordinators.



There are several testing sessions on Friday. For every sessions, there is a specific sticker and every participant needs a sticker for the right turn. The stickers are available in race Office:

Dismantling

Teams are allowed to break down their tents and hospitalities from Sunday, 05 June after their last session . All trailers, hospitalities and tents must be removed from the paddock till Sunday, 05 June before 8 p.m.





5. Sporting

Collection of documents / licence control

The licence control will take place on Friday from 09:00 to 14:00. A more detailed schedule will be sent separately in the days before the Rundstreckentrophy.

Location: in the racing tower – ground floor – left door "Race Office"

Make sure you bring all relevant documents.

PLEASE NOTE: the testing sessions on Friday are <u>not covered by license</u>, because the Rundstreckentrophy officially begins from the first Free Practice/Qualifying on. You have the possibility to pay for an extra accident insurance (€ 10 per day), at latest until Thursday 20:00 with the following information:

Parc Ferme

Parc Ferme will be located in the series paddocks or in the official parc ferme at the end of the building

Supplementary Regulations

All important documents will be sent to the teams separately or handed over at the license control.

Timekeeping

Transponders have to be collected itself at the timekeeping in the race tower 1. floor. Deposit is \leq 100 for every transponder, rental fee is \leq 20,00. TAG Heuer and Chronolec transponders are not compatible!

Insurance for guardrail for qualifying and race:

There is no insurance for guardrail, so every driver must pay for their damage. We offer the possibility to pay \in 150 to reduce the maximum fee to \in 500 for every single case of damage. If a driver participates in 2 classes (e.g. FIA CEZ sprint and endurance), the amout to pay is: \in 200




Directions to Red Bull Ring

Hospitality catering

For teams, drivers or sponsors it is not allowed to bring external (party) catering companies to the circuit for public purposes unless there are specific agreements with the Red Bull Ring circuit or the organizer.

Pit Lane Behaviours







Drones

It is strictly prohibited to make use of a drone without permission of the circuit media coordinator, because the Red Bull Ring is located in a military air raid shelter.

Operating hours

Due to binding regulations under public law and administrative penalties, the facility, and in particular the race track, can only be used during the following operating hours.

Operating hours race track and motorsport facility: 08:30 to 12:00 and 13:00 to 18:00

Driving on and/or any other use of the race track outside the operating hours is prohibited for all participants of the event without exception. 5 minutes before the end of each operating time, the race track will automatically be switched to red and everyone must leave the race track and immediately go to the pit or paddock.

Outside the above-mentioned operating hours, a rest period (engine rest, no music, no noise, etc.) is to be observed in the outdoor area of all facilities, as well as in the pits.

Traffic

All vehicles must drive at walking speed on all access and connecting roads and in the paddock.

Parking

Parking is permitted only in designated areas. Vehicles that are not parked legally will be towed away for a fee.





Waste

The entire Red Bull Ring must be kept clean. Garbage must be disposed in the garbage cans provided.

Smoking

Smoking is allowed only in the designated places.

Sampling/distribution of flyers

Sampling and distribution of flyers without approval by the circuit management is prohibited.

Damages

The causer is liable for any damage to the Red Bull Ring facility. In particular, drilling holes and attaching materials to all buildings (pit buildings, facades, walls, fences, barriers, lighting systems, kiosks, poles, roofs and outdoor facilities) are strictly prohibited. Painting and labeling of the facilities is also prohibited.

Advertisement & Marketing

It is expressly prohibited to name, depict and/or advertise such third parties that manufacture, sell, distribute, market or advertise energy drinks (i.e. beverages containing caffeine, turin and/or guarana that are marketed as energy drinks) and/or offer mobile services, and/or their products.





Information about the truck driving ban in Austria

We would like to inform you that there is a general ban on night driving on all roads from 22:00 to 05:00 throughout Austria for trucks with a maximum permissible gross vehicle weight of more than 7.5 tons. In addition, there is a weekend driving ban on the entire Austrian road network for trucks and articulated vehicles. This takes effect on Saturdays from 15:00 to 24:00 and on Sundays from 00:00 to 22:00. This affects trucks without trailers and semi-trailer vehicles over 7.5 t maximum permissible gross weight as well as with trailers if the maximum permissible gross weight of the truck or trailer is more than 3.5 t.

Should you wish to travel home or continue your journey on Saturday or Sunday, you will require an exemption permit from the Styrian provincial government for each truck and semi-trailer vehicle. To apply for an exemption, register at <u>www.e-gov.ooe.gv.at</u> at least

2 weeks before the start of the event and fill out the appropriate form to ensure timely processing.

In the event that your intended driving route involves several Austrian provinces, a separate application must be submitted to each authority concerned.
