2. Organization

Paddock access:

- Entry to the paddock on Thursday, 19.09.2023 between 18:00 and 20:00.
- Entry on Friday morning for trucks via the track from 07:00 - 07:45 and between 12:00 and 13:00 and again in the evening from 18:00.
- Entry for trucks on Saturday and Sunday only with prior permission from BG Sportpromotion GmbH.
- The paddock should be cleared by 20:00 on Sunday, 22.09.
- If necessary, overnight accommodation can be provided in the paddock from Sunday to Monday (please let us know).

Accreditations (access authorizations):

- Handover of personal accreditations per series collected by the series coordinators from Thursday evening 18:00 in the race office.
- Vehicle accreditations: There are the areas Paddock (for trucks and vehicles that remain in the driver's paddock for the entire duration of the event), Box (for vehicles parked in the pit area) and Team for team members. The driver accreditations will be sent to the series in advance via print@home ticket and exchanged for stickers on site by the security staff.

Please remember to pick up your accreditations, from Saturday onwards access without accreditation is no longer possible

Pits:

- If you would like to have your own box, please contact your series coordinator. They will be able to help you with the relevant information.
- Pit keys are handed out in the race office. A deposit of € 100,- per box will be taken when collecting the box keys, which will be refunded when the keys are returned.

Parking spaces:

- There are sufficient parking spaces available. These will be released gradually to ensure disciplined parking with sufficient distance.

3. Paddock

Paddock plan:

- The paddock plan will be sent out separately. As soon as all dimensions have been finalized, a detailed plan will be drawn and sent out to you.
- We would ask you to take a close look at this plan in advance to ensure a smooth paddock set-up.

4. Sporting procedure

Drivers Briefing:

- According to the supplementary regulations.

Race Office:

- The race office is located at the beginning of the pit building.

Administrative Checks:

- The series coordinators can take care of the administrative checks for all drivers in their series.
- The following are required:
 - Admin list with original signature of the drivers and the following information: Applicant/applicant license/driver/rider license/nation Driver as per license/vehicle make and type/class
 - Signature list of the drivers that they have received, read and understood the written driver briefing.
 - Original licenses (no photos!) of the drivers and/or applicants (these will be returned to the series coordinators after checking).

- signed disclaimer from the driver
- **IMPORTANT: Participants under the age of 18 must present an applicant license in addition to their license.**
- Foreign drivers require a foreign starting permit from their ASN if this is not noted on the license. **PLEASE NOTE: Personal accident insurance:**
 - Please check whether your license includes accident insurance that also covers free tests: Friday - the free tests are not part of the event. If you would like to have such insurance, please contact us as soon as possible at administration@bg-sportpromotion.com We will then contact our insurance company and provide the necessary information (costs 15,-)**The insurance can also be taken out on site at the race office until max. 08:30 for the respective day.**

Scrutineering:

- Scrutineering is carried out by the respective series technicians (except PRTC).

Transponder:

- The transponders will be handed out on Friday at the timekeeping in the pit tower on the 1st floor. The rental fee is € 20.00. TAG Heuer and Chronolec transponders are not compatible and drivers with such a transponder must borrow one. Deposit € 100.

Pre-start area:

- The pre-start area for the racing series in the paddock is located on the access route from the paddock to the pit lane.

Outlap after Chequered Flag:

- a complete lap after the chequered flag and then into the pit lane and back to the respective paddock. Depending on the situation, the outlap can also be shortened and driven over the short connection.

Parc Fermé:

- We will have a separate parc fermé in the main paddock and behind the pits.

Noise regulations:

- A maximum of 105dB applies. Loud vehicles will be taken out of the session and can modify once. If a reduction in accordance with the maximum specifications cannot be achieved, the car will no longer take part in the event. In concrete terms: At the Salzburgring, the LWA measurement procedure is used in accordance with the applicable DMSB regulations. More precisely defined, we allow 105 db (A) measured at a distance of 25 meters, which corresponds to an LWA value of 141 db (A).

Podium:

- The podium is located in the pit building (1st floor)

- Class / division awards will be held by the series themselves.

Test-Sessions:

- Sessions can be booked online for the test day as part of the Motorsport Festival.
- One ticket per turn is created for each booking. Each ticket must be exchanged for a sticker at the race office beforehand. Please find below the link for the bookings:

Track walk:

- Thursday and Friday from 18:30 - 20:00 with scooter, bike or on foot allowed

Truck driving ban in Austria:

- We would like to inform you that there is a general ban on night driving on all roads throughout Austria from 22:00 to 05:00 for trucks with a maximum permissible gross weight of more than 7.5 tons. In addition, a weekend and public holiday driving ban applies to trucks and articulated vehicles on the entire Austrian road network. This applies on Saturdays from 15:00 to 24:00 and on Sundays and public holidays from 00:00 to 22:00. This applies to trucks without trailers and articulated lorries over 7.5 tons gross vehicle weight and with trailers if the gross vehicle weight of the truck or trailer is more than 3.5 tons.
- To apply for an exemption permit, please register at least 2 weeks before the start of the event at https://www.salzburg.gv.at/verkehr/_/Seiten/wochenend.aspx and complete the relevant form to ensure timely processing.
- If you have any problems with this, please do not hesitate to contact us.
- If your planned route passes through several Austrian federal states, a separate application must be submitted to each authority.

Night Patrol:

- A night guard will patrol the area. If teams require explicit security for their area, equipment, etc., this can be optionally booked through the organizer. The organizer assumes no liability for theft, vandalism, etc.

Payments:

- The organizer has a cashless payment system in the race office that accepts major credit cards as well as EC cards.

Damage to the event area and the track:

- We would like to point out that any damage, e.g. on the track or in the paddock (e.g. pegs) must be reimbursed by the perpetrator. Please also refer to the attached ring rules.
- Guardrail damage: it is possible to buy an insurance: € 200 for the weekend, € 800 excess per claim. Otherwise the damage will be charged at the original amount (without surcharges).

Catering at the Ring:

- The Gasthaus am Ring is open directly at the Salzburgring
- Team and crew catering is permitted on your own. All other catering rights (catering for guests etc.) are held by Salzburgring or BG Sportpromotion GmbH and require prior written approval.
